PHONE CONVERSATION: Mr. Dighe stated that he would like to run the modeling software, and was wondering if he could obtain the AERMOD software along with the modeling files. I told Mr. Dighe he had the option of review the output files in a text form, however he has concerns regarding the input parameters that were assumed by the applicants. He wanted to run the program with appropriate assumptions himself. - 5. He does not think the tables in the AFC well describe how the criteria pollutants will be directly affecting his community.
- 6. He would like to run the program and the CD files, and process his independent analysis before the PSA for Mariposa is published.
