The California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) has authorized Contra Costa County to act as our delegate Chief Building Official (CBO) for the construction oversight inspection process of the Oakley Generating Station power plant project. As such, Contra Costa County will be entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Energy Commission for inspection services related to your project. Pursuant to this activity, Contra Costa County as the Energy Commission's CBO shall enforce conditions of certification, issue permits, review drawings, and coordinate all aspects of the construction inspection process through completion of your project.

Jason Crapo, Deputy Director for the Building Inspection Division of Contra Costa County will be contacting you soon to discuss the inspection process and the required contract between Radback Energy and Contra Costa County for inspection services cost reimbursement.

The Energy Commission has not yet made a decision regarding the certification and approval of the Oakley Generation Station project. Any costs or fees incurred by Radback Energy prior to Energy Commission certification for plan review and delegate CBO work with Contra Costa County, will be at your own risk.
