The Energy Commission staff is currently in the process of completing its review of the pre-construction requirements for the GWF Tracy Combined Cycle Power Plant Project and has determined that installing a construction trailer at the project site and power to the trailer may commence as of December 1, 2010.

Biological monitors shall accompany the crew during all activities.

Review of the pre-construction submittals will continue and you will be given a full notice to proceed for all other activities when all pre-construction submittals are approved as required by the conditions of certification. The Energy Commission will continue to work closely with GWF Power Systems to ensure conformance with all conditions of certification as written in the Energy Commission's Final Decision. Lack of conformance with any of the conditions of certification may result in suspension of construction activities.
