

## Subject: STAFF'S PMPD COMMENTS SET 3 -RICE SOLAR ENERGY PROJECT (09-AFC-10)



Enclosed is Set 3 of staff's comments on the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision (PMPD) for the Rice Solar Energy Project (RSEP). At the December 3, 2010 PMPD Conference, the Committee encouraged staff and applicant to develop mutually acceptable language to address the rescue and medical aid functions under Worker Safety and Fire Protection. Staff and applicant have done so, and the proposed updates to the PMPD are as enclosed.

With respect to Conditions of Certification WORKERSAFETY-9 and -10, please use the applicant's proposed changes as filed in their PMPD Comments dated November 30, 2010. Staff agrees with these changes. With respect to Condition of Certification WORKERSAFETY-7 whereby the applicant proposed that its payment to Riverside County Fire Department (RCFD) be issued as a Letter of Credit, staff and applicant remain in disagreement.

As part of the resolution to the rescue function, staff and applicant have agreed to a new Condition of Certification WORKERSAFETY-11 as enclosed. Staff believes this will allow verification that the rescue capabilities for which the RCFD is normally relied upon are in fact being provided onsite. Staff believes that the required rescue capability could be provided either directly by the applicant, or by construction companies under contract for particular types of construction.

The proposed changes to the PMPD Worker Safety and Fire Protection section are as follows:

## Proposed changes to PMPD Page 8, Paragraph 1:

Should RCFD and the Applicant reach agreement such <u>To the extent that the RCFD</u> and <u>REMS determine</u> that the RSEP may lawfully provide on-site emergency medical and rescue services, we would require the project owner to comply with Conditions of Certification WORKER SAFETY-9, <u>-10</u> and -<del>10-</del><u>11</u>. These Conditions are based on the Applicant's submitted Revised Fire Needs Assessment (Ex. 50). Implementation of these conditions will shorten the crucial time-to-treatment and reduce the time-tohospital for injured workers, while at the same time reducing potential demands on and impacts to RCFD resources, benefitting both workers and the community.

# Proposed changes to PMPD Page 9, Paragraph 4:

Notwithstanding these evidentiary deficiencies, we find that the project's potential incremental impact on the identified cumulative impacts could be significant. RSEP must therefore make a monetary contribution to be applied to RCFD's mitigation efforts. Based on the limited cost figures submitted by Staff by way of Staff-proposed Condition of Certification Worker <u>Safety-7</u>, the County's development fee impact program1, and project's expected payment of property taxes, we find that RSEP's onetime payment of the development impact fee, property taxes, and a onetime payment of \$570,000 will reduce the incremental impact to less than significant levels. These requirements are set forth in Condition of Certification WORKER-7.

# Proposed New Condition of Certification Worker Safety-11

WORKER SAFETY-11: The project owner shall provide the CPM with a schedule indicating when construction activities that create the potential for rescue incidents will be ongoing, the type of construction to be done, the names of the rescue team members to be onsite, and documentation showing that the rescue team members have the appropriate training.

**Verification:** At least 60 days prior to the commencement of any construction activities that create the potential for rescue incidents, the project owner shall provide to the Safety Monitor (provided for in Worker Safety-4) for review and to the CPM for review and approval:

- A. a schedule indicating when the construction activities will occur;
- B. a description of the type of construction to be done;
- C. the names of the rescue team members to be onsite; and
- D. <u>documentation showing that the rescue team members have the</u> <u>appropriate training.</u>
