Dear Mr. Hoffman:

My property is located one half mile from the project and my concerns are ... what will be the fall out of the exhaust that will be coming out of the plant that will be a health issue to my family?

What will be the air quality and the Thermal Plumes emissions and what will it do to my home and property?

Mariposa said that there will not be any noise heard any different than we have now. If that is not the case after the plant is built, what is our recourse?

I am very concerned about my family living on Kelso Road, two children and two adults, i.e., I am very concerned about their safety and the health environment near my home. My children are there 24/7 and 365 days a year. What if delivery trucks start using Kelso Road and the potential traffic hazards to my family and grandchildren?

At the meeting the staff panel stated they did the "air quality" and other "air/wind" test at the Tracy Airport which is at least 12 miles south east of the project which is an entirely different wind dynamics from here. You may note that there are no windmills at the Tracy Airport. You may want to check with Enxco and Seawest Windpower Companies to see the studies they have done on the wind in the Mariposa Energy Plant area.
