As part of the Business Meeting to be held on January 12, 2011, the Energy Commission will consider adopting the Committee Final 2010 Integrated Energy Policy Report Update (2010 IEPR Update). The document is posted on the Energy Commission website at: [www.energy.ca.gov/2010_energypolicy/index.html].

Background

Senate Bill 1389 (Bowen and Sher, Chapter 568, Statutes of 2002) requires the Energy Commission to "conduct assessments and forecasts of all aspects of energy industry supply, production, transportation, delivery and distribution, demand, and prices. The Energy Commission shall use these assessments and forecasts to develop energy policies that conserve resources, protect the environment, ensure energy reliability, enhance the state's economy, and protect public health and safety." (Public Resources Code § 25301[a]). This assessment and associated policy recommendations are reported and adopted every two years.

SB 1389 also requires the Energy Commission to prepare an update in alternate years to provide a progress report on issues raised in the biennial IEPR or to identify new issues that have arisen during the intervening year. The adopted 2010 IEPR Update will fulfill that requirement.

The focus of the 2010 IEPR Update is on California's transition to a clean energy economy and the contribution of federal stimulus funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) to that transition. In preparing the report, the IEPR Committee held six public workshops that covered the various ARRA-funded programs administered by the Energy Commission. On October 14, 2010, the IEPR Committee published the Committee Draft 2010 IEPR Update, and on November 1, 2010, held a hearing to solicit public comments on the report. The Committee Final 2010 IEPR Update reflects the Committee's consideration of both oral and written comments from stakeholders on the draft report.

Written Comments

The IEPR Committee will accept comments on the Committee Final 2010 IEPR Update and requests parties to submit comments in writing by 5 p.m. on **January 5, 2011**, so that comments can be considered prior to the January 12, 2011 Business Meeting.
