

Project Title: Adoption of Revisions to the State Energy Program Guidelines.

<u>Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:</u> The purpose of this activity is to revise guidelines previously adopted by the California Energy Commission to govern the administration of its State Energy Program pursuant to Public Resources Code Sections 25460 - 25464. The guidelines describe how the Energy Commission will implement its State Energy Program and identify available funding, eligibility criteria, the evaluation and award process, and other requirements to qualify for funding under the program elements. The guidelines were revised to clarify the conditions under which the Energy Commission may reimburse grant and loan awardees for expenses incurred after the Energy Commission's approval of an awardee's agreement, but prior to the agreement's execution. The California Energy Commission and participants of the State Energy Program benefit from the adoption of revisions to these guidelines.
