Contra Contra Generating Station LLC (CCGS LLC) is the owner of the Oakley Generating Station (OGS), formerly known as the Contra Costa Generating Station (CCGS). CCGS LLC, requests that the attached information be designated confidential pursuant to a Repeated Application for Confidential Designation under Title 20, Division 2, Chapter 7, Article 2, Section 2505(a)(4) of the California Code of Regulations (CCRs). This information is being supplied to the California Energy Commission (CEC) as Response to Data Request 74, Transmission Line Reconductoring Analysis – Cultural Resources Literature Search Results.
