The purpose of this letter is to state our support for the California Energy Commission's (CEC) AB 118 Investment Plan for 2011-12 (AB 118 Investment Plan). We understand that the CEC's goal is to develop and deploy alternative and renewable fuels and advanced transportation technologies. This AB 118 Investment Plan will help to meet the state's goals for reducing greenhouse gas emissions and petroleum dependence in the transportation sector.

Environ Strategy Consultants, Inc. (Environ Strategy) is an environmental consulting and engineering firm that specializes in Biomethane projects that use waste products such as brewery waste and food waste to generate the renewable Biomethane for use in energy production. We are involved in a project in southern California that is planning to make a renewable fuel from Biomethane for use in heavy duty solid waste collection vehicles. If the CEC's AB 118 Investment Plan funds are available, we will apply for funding to build a pilot project that will create a renewable fuel from Biomethane. Specifically we are going to apply for the AB 118 Investment Plan funds to support Biomethane production from waste-based, pre-landfill feedstocks such as food waste, and then convert the Biomethane to CNG fuel. Therefore we are supporting the AB 118 Investment Plan proposed use of grant funding of up to \$8 million for the use of Biomethane in the production of transportation fuels.
