Dear Mr. Leao and Mr. Singh:

My Company, J's Communications, has been in business since 1991 and we service hundreds of customers in the agriculture, construction, trucking and other industries with two-way radios and systems. I am writing because of my concern over the proposed rule changes in a short two years.

The type of products I sell typically last for a long period of time, (5-10 years), and are expensive for any customer to purchase. If my customers are forced to buy a different battery besides a Ni-Cad, they must buy a different charger as well. This will create quite a lot of unnecessary confusion, unnecessary cost and continuous conversations on "why".

Many of my Public Safety customers simply do not have budgets to replace working equipment due to the many cuts on the State and Federal levels. Please consider an alternative to the proposed changes.

Is it possible to consider extending the deadline out additional years, if you must push this through at all? This would be advantageous to us as a small business operating in California.

As with most small business, if my customers do not have the funds to purchase equipment, there is no need for me to sell it thus potentially closing a business that has been in service for 20 years and adding to the unemployment rate.
