The East Altamont Energy Center Power Plant Project was certified by the Commission on August 20, 2003. The project as licensed is a 1,100 megawatt natural gas fired combined-cycle power plant located in unincorporated Alameda County approximately one mile west of San Joaquin County Line and 1 mile southeast of the Contra Costa County line.

On March 23, 2011, Calpine Corporation submitted a letter to the Commission indicating that Calpine no longer intends to build the project and requests that the Commission Decision and license for this project be terminated.

**CONCLUSION AND ORDER**

There being no objection and good cause having been shown, the California Energy Commission hereby grants the request by Calpine to terminate the Commission Decision and license effective March 23, 2011.
