Dear Ms. Luckhardt:

Your letter dated September 8, 2011, addressed to Chairman Weisenmiller and Chief Counsel Michael Levy but with the salutation "Dear Committee Members," was referred to me for reply.

I will begin by pointing out that your letter is an ex parte communication with a decision-maker, which is impermissible under California law (see, e.g. California Government Code section 11430.10). You were advised of the applicability of ex parte rules in an email exchange you had with Mr. Levy on August 4, 2011; at that time you indicated your understanding that you could communicate about the DyoCore matter with Energy Commission staff as an independent party including staff attorneys who represent the staff, but that further communication with Commissioners and their advisors must be subject to the ex parte rules.

Thus, pursuant to Government Code section 11430.5, your letter is being docketed and served upon all parties in this proceeding to notify them that the communication has occurred and been made a part of the record.

With regard to the substance of your letter, the Committee cannot comment because the matter, in which your client has become a party, is pending before it and the legal and factual issues have not yet been finally resolved.

With regard to the procedural implications of your letter, I wish simply to point out that, as a party in the DyoCore matter, your client must pursue its administrative remedies before seeking recourse elsewhere. I encourage you to participate fully in this proceeding. Shortly a new notice setting a date for the Prehearing Conference will be issued, and it will list several categories of information that the Committee is interested in receiving from the parties. While I cannot give you the entire list at this time, I can

advise you that one area of interest will be the pricing methodology used by the distributors of DyoCore products, including your client.

I look forward to working with you on this complex matter.
