

In accordance with the provisions of Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(a), California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) staff reviewed your petition dated August 3, 2011 requesting to erect a new 1,532 square-foot structural steel and metal frame warehouse on land that is currently being used for outdoor storage. Staff determined that the petition meets the criteria of section 1769(a)(2), and mailed the enclosed "Notice of Determination" to the Energy Commission's post-certification project mailing list on September 19, 2011.
