Richard Polich Senior Line Leader - Renewable Energy at KEMA, Inc.

Mr. Polich will provide testimony regarding two reports created by KEMA, Inc. ("KEMA"): that evaluate performance claims made by DyoCore, Inc. ("DyoCore") regarding the DyoCore SolAir wind turbine ("DyoCore turbine"): (1) the July 25, 2011 report referenced in staff's complaint against DyoCore ("KEMA Report"), which is referenced in this proceeding as Exhibit D of the Complaint, which is Exhibit 1 of Complainant's exhibits; and, (2) and testimony dated October 4, 2011 that presents supplemental analysis regarding the data supplied by DyoCore, referenced in this proceeding as Exhibit 91.

Mr. Polich's testimony will include:

- KEMA's analysis of the data submitted by DyoCore for the purposes of listing the DyoCore turbine
 - Explanation of the methodology and theories relied upon in the analysis
 - Explanation of the conclusions reached in the analysis regarding
 DyoCore's power curve, power rating, and annual energy production claims

Case van Dam

Mr. van Dam is a professor of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering at the University of California Davis, as well as the director of the California Wind Energy Collaborative.

Mr. van Dam's testimony will include:

- Established testing and measuring methodologies for the performance of small wind turbines
- Available standards for performance testing of small wind turbines

 Providing analysis of data submitted by DyoCore to the Energy Commission for the purposes of receiving listing of their turbine

Trudy Forsyth

Ms. Forsyth is an employee of the Alliance for Sustainable Energy, LLC (the managing and operating contractor for the National Renewable Energy Laboratory under Department of Energy Contract Number DE-AC36-08GO28308). Ms. Forsyth's ability to testify is subject to further Department of Energy program approval. If it is ultimately determined that Ms. Forsyth will not provide testimony in this proceeding, then the Energy Commission will revise the witness list accordingly.

Ms. Forsyth's testimony will include:

- History of standards and certification for small wind turbines
- Presence of valid, and widely-accepted, methods for testing and collecting data for small wind turbines during the relevant time period, from approximately 2009-2010
