Dear Commissioners Douglas and Weisenmiller and Hearing Officer Vaccaro:

We write to respond and object to Ms. Burch's inflammatory letter filed this afternoon. The misstatements included are so egregious that it is hard to believe that they are anything less than intentional.

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Ms. Burch claims that I argued at the hearing yesterday afternoon that "it was not until March 2011 . . . that K Road Calico knew that SunCatchers were economically unviable, commercially unavailable and decided to convert the Calico Solar Project to a primarily PV project." Having been at the hearing, you must know that this is not true. It is once again an attempt by BNSF to prove an alleged falsehood with an actual falsehood.

To clarify, I argued that BNSF made numerous misrepresentation in its Verified Complaint, including Paragraph 15 which states:

Just three weeks later, on December 24, 2010, Tessera Solar North America consummated its sale of Applicant, Calico Solar, LLC ("Calico"), to K Road Sun LLC, a subsidiary of K-Road Power, which is a company that focuses on PV power. At that time, Tessera Solar announced that it had done so, because had it [sic] determined that "SunCatchers would not be commercially viable in the near term." See Exhibit H. [CEC Calico Solar Amendment at page 3-1, §3.1.](emphasis added).

As I explained yesterday, the quoted language is inaccurate as to who made the statement, when the statement was made, and what the statement was. The quote is not an announcement by Tessera Solar, it is a quote from Calico in its request for amendment. It was not made at the time of the sale as indicated by BNSF, but rather in March, when Calico filed its Petition to Amend. Finally, it is simply a misquote. The

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amendment does not say that "the project would not be commercially viable in the near term" but rather it says that "the SunCatcher would not be commercially *available* in the near term."

Calico Solar objects to BNSF's request to admit additional evidence. The request is procedurally incorrect and substantively devoid of merit.
