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On September 14, 2011, the Orange Grove Energy, L.P., the project owner filed a petition with the California Energy Commission requesting to modify the Orange Grove Project. The 96-megawatt project was certified by the Energy Commission on April 8, 2009, and began temporary operation on May 10, 2010. The facility is located in the unincorporated area of Pala, in San Diego County.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION

The modifications proposed in the petition would make the Conditions of Certification consistent with conditions proposed by the San Diego Air Pollution Control District (APCD) for the permit to operate.

STAFF DETERMINATION AND AMENDMENT REVIEW PROCESS

The purpose of the Energy Commission's review process is to assess any impacts the proposed modifications would have on environmental quality and public health and safety. The process includes an evaluation of the consistency of the proposed changes with the Energy Commission's Decision, and, if the project, as modified, will remain in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (Title 20, Calif. Code of Regulations, section 1769). Energy Commission staff is currently analyzing the petition and will publish an analysis in the near future. A public hearing for the purpose of approving or denying the amendment petition will be held at a regularly scheduled Energy Commission business meeting.

This Notice of Receipt is being mailed to interested parties and property owners adjacent to the project site who may want to participate in the amendment process.
