**Subject:** R-2 Chages for DyoCore R-2 holders

I am the holder of an R-2 issued by the California Energy Commission for the installation of six DyoCore Wind Generators and I am asking the committee reveiwng problems with these R-2's to immediately allow all holders of these R-2's to change the wind generators to another wind generator on the approved equipment list.

As for me, I did my own research with regards to the DyoCore wind generators and concluded about six months ago that the DyoCore wind generators could not and would not produce the capacity of electricity generation that they stated, thus I changed from the six DyoCore wind generators to three of the HY-3000 wind generators. I immediately submitted my plans to the County of San Bernardino and began construction of my new system in the last four weeks. The system will be up and running shortly. ( As a side note, in the area I am installing my new system in is very windy, as a Bergy 10,000 watt system installed on the neighboring property to mine produced over 12,000 KW in that last twelve months.)

The R-2 implies that I can switch from manufacturer, as long as I select from the CEC approved generators. As a matter of fairness, the committee reviewing this entire problem with DyoCore should immediately allow all holders of DyoCore R-2's to switch to another approved manufacturer. This would reduce the number of potential future problems with these R-2 holders and would also allow the intent of the program, more alternative energy production, to take place.

Thank you for allowing me to state my concerns, and I look forward to a positive ruling in the coming days.

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
