NOTICE OF POSTPONEMENT OF HEARING FOR CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ADOPTION

Amendments to the Appliance Efficiency Regulations and Proposed Negative Declaration
(Battery Charger Systems and Self-Contained Lighting Controls)

Docket No. 11-AAER-2

The Notice of Proposed Action¹ and Notice of Availability and Hearing² set a date of November 30, 2011, for consideration and possible adoption by the California Energy Commission of the proposed amendments to the Appliance Efficiency Regulations of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations relating to energy efficiency standards and other requirements for battery charger systems and self-contained lighting controls, and consideration and adoption of the proposed Negative Declaration, including a Finding of No Significant Impact under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), for those proposed amendments. **The Commission will not consider adoption of these matters on November 30, 2011, and the hearing date for consideration and possible adoption of both the proposed amendments and the Negative Declaration has been postponed to a later date to be announced.** This will allow for additional time to review and consider comments received during the 45-day comment period, and to determine whether changes to the proposed amendments are warranted.

This postponement is authorized by Section 11346.8(b) of the California Government Code. The new hearing date for both the proposed amendments and the Negative Declaration will be noticed in compliance with the provisions of Section 11346.8(b) of the California Government Code and Section 1223(c) of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations. If changes are made to the proposed amendments pursuant to Section 11346.8(c) of the California Government Code, the full text of the amendments, with the changes clearly indicated, will be made available to the public for at least 15 days prior to the hearing scheduled for consideration and possible adoption of the proposed amendments.
