PIO PICO ENERGY CENTER (11-AFC-1), STAFF'S FOURTH PROPOSED REVISED Subject: SCHEDULE

Per the Committee's Scheduling Order dated May 24, 2011, staff is hereby notifying the Committee that staff encountered a delay in completing and publishing the Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA). As discussed in staff's October 6, 2011 scheduling memo to the Committee, the applicant was working to revise their air modeling to predict impacts to air quality. Following that effort, the San Diego Air Pollution Control District published its Preliminary Determination of Compliance ("PDOC") on December 16, 2011 which was approximately seven weeks later than staff anticipated. Because issuance of the PDOC is a precursor to staff completing its air quality analysis, publication of the PSA will be delayed.

The PSA is now undergoing internal review and staff is planning to publish the PSA by February 7, 2012. The staff has discussed this proposed schedule with the applicant who does not object. Therefore, staff is requesting the Committee adopt staff's Fourth Proposed Revised Schedule, attached here.
