As part of the February 8 Business Meeting, the Energy Commission will consider adoption of changes to the *State Energy Program Guidelines* (Guidelines). The *Guidelines* were developed to implement and administer specific program areas funded by the State Energy Program (SEP) under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009.

The proposed changes to the *Guidelines* extend the program deadline from March 31, 2012 to April 30, 2012, consistent with the Energy Commission's ARRA SEP award from the U.S. Department of Energy. In addition, references to the Energy Commission's former American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Ad Hoc Committee are deleted and replaced with a reference to the Energy Commission's Executive Director. The Executive Director will now be authorized to carry out certain activities as specified in the proposed changes
