Integrated Energy Policy Report

I. BACKGROUND

Senate Bill 1389 (Bowen, Chapter 568, Statutes of 2002) requires the Energy Commission to "conduct assessments and forecasts of all aspects of energy industry supply, production, transportation, delivery and distribution, demand, and prices. The Energy Commission shall use these assessments and forecasts to develop energy policies that conserve resources, protect the environment, ensure energy reliability, enhance the state's economy, and protect public health and safety." (Public Resources Code § 25301(a)). The Integrated Energy Policy report (IEPR) contains these assessments and associated policy recommendations and is adopted every two years.

The 2011 Integrated Energy Policy Report Scoping Order was first released on August 31, 2010, and then revised on March 30, 2011, to identify the topics to be covered in the 2011 IEPR.

From October 2010 to December 2011, thirty workshops were conducted on topics including: electricity and natural gas supply, demand, and infrastructure; transportation fuel supply, demand, and infrastructure; energy efficiency; renewables and distributed generation; nuclear energy; clean energy workforce development; energy storage; and public interest energy research benefits.

On December 5, 2011, the IEPR Lead Commissioner released the *Lead Commissioner Draft 2011 IEPR* and asked for written comments from the public. After considering all the comments received in writing, the Lead Commissioner released the *Lead Commissioner Final 2011 IEPR* on January 25, 2012.

II. ACTION TAKEN

At a regularly scheduled business meeting on February 8, 2012, the Energy Commission, after receiving comments and discussing the item, voted unanimously to approve the *Lead Commissioner Final 2011 IEPR*.

It is hereby ordered that a final version of this document shall be forwarded to the Governor for his review pursuant to Public Resources Code section 25307, and be made available to the public and the Legislature.

The Energy Commission hereby directs the Executive Director and staff to prepare the *2011 IEPR* under the guidance of the Lead Commissioner.

It is so Ordered.
