Thank you for taking the time to read this correspondence. The Quail Brush Power Generation Facility that has been proposed on the eastern rim of San Diego causes me great concern. As a Registered Nurse the health risks to the public outweigh the benefits created by the electricity generated by the facility.

My primary concern is for the health of at risk populations. These populations include children and the elderly. Children's lungs are not completely developed making them susceptible to many respiratory ailments. West Hills High School, Carlton Oaks Elementary School, and Sycamore Canyon Elementary School are all dangerously close to this proposed power plant.
