I understand that there is some proposed changes pending to the above referenced standards to make our State move towards more energy efficient gains pertaining to Fenestration. I as a licensed contractor in California I think these changes could have a dramatic impact for reducing the overall energy consumption for thousands of residences throughout the State.

However, by mandating a more stringent standard, you will effectively eliminate a large portion of my business that is dedicated to the replacement of less efficient skylights. I propose allowing skylights that meet the current Energy Star requirements to be used to replace old, outdated, inefficient skylights.

Finally for new construction, I would like to see an increase to the standard exemption from 10 SF up to 16 SF of Skylight Glazing to meet the current Energy Star requirements. Lets not slow down how Californian's have overwhelming embraced how skylights bring natural daylight efficiently into any room.
