## PURPOSE

The purpose of the workshop is to allow staff, the applicant, intervenors, interested agencies, and the public to discuss several technical disciplines, including but not limited to Biological Resources, Land Use, Socioeconomics, Traffic & Transportation, Transmission System Engineering, Water Resources and Visual Resources.

## BACKGROUND

On August 5, 2011, Hidden Hills Solar Holdings, LLC, submitted an Application for Certification (AFC) to construct and operate the Hidden Hills Solar Electric Generating System (HHSEGS). If approved, HHSEGS would be located on approximately 3,277 acres of privately owned land leased in Inyo County, California, immediately adjacent to the Nevada border. The project site is approximately 8 miles southeast of Pahrump, Nevada, and approximately 45 miles northwest of Las Vegas, Nevada. On October 5, 2011 the Commission approved the Executive Director's recommendation that the AFC was deemed "Data Adequate" and commenced the Commission's 12-month facilities review process. The Energy Commission staff has begun its discovery and analysis of the HHSEGS project, and will use information obtained from the Workshop discussions in the preparation of its Preliminary Staff Assessment of the project.

## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

As proposed, HHSEGS would comprise two solar fields and associated facilities located approximately 45 miles northwest of Las Vegas, NV in Inyo County, CA. If approved, each solar plant would generate 250 megawatts (MW), for a total net output of 500 MW. Each solar plant would use approximately 85,000 heliostats—elevated mirrors guided by a tracking system mounted on a pylon—to focus the sun's rays on a solar receiver steam generator (SRSG) atop a 750-foot tall solar power tower near the center of each solar field. The transmission line and natural gas pipeline are both located wholly within the state of Nevada on federal land managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). These project linears will be reviewed under the National Environmental Policy ACT (NEPA), for which BLM is the lead agency:
