

#### Regarding Operational Security:

- 1. Facility will be enclosed by a chain link security fence. The fence will be 8-feet in height (7-foot fabric with 1-foot of 3 strand barb wire).
- 2. Secured entrance (motorized cantilevered gate) where the access road meets the facility perimeter fencing.
- 3. The facility will be staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- 4. Video surveillance will be provided and monitored at the control room.
- 5. Access to the facility will be by key card, or call box, at the entrance gate.
- 6. Signage will be installed as required by the authorities having jurisdiction.

### Regarding Construction Security:

- 1. Project site and laydown area security are contractually the responsibility of the EPC contractor.
- 2. EPC contractor will provide security personnel, equipment, and systems to secure the project.
- 3. A badging system will be implemented to identify all contractor and subcontractor personnel.
- 4. A storage and material control plan will be implemented to insure the accurate tracking of all purchased materials.
- 5. Signage will be installed as required by the authorities having jurisdiction.
