The Marsh Landing Generating Station Project is a 760-megawatt

project that was certified by the Energy Commission on August 25,

2010.

Modification Description:

The primary purpose for this amendment is to incorporate design refinements to the project that have been identified during additional design work that occurred after the Commission Decision was issued. This additional design work is typical after a project has been approved and the changes are necessary for final design.

The primary modifications proposed in the petition are as follows:

- Two 5 MMbtu/hr pre-heaters replaced with two 8 (MMbtu/hr) natural gas fired pre-heaters;
- Water treatment configuration changes;
- The ammonia system to have single wall piping instead of double wall piping between the storage tank and the ammonia injection skids. A slightly modified above-ground containment area and underground sump. The drain will be slightly smaller at 38-inches in diameter. Ttruck unloading area slightly modified above-ground containment area and the drain will be slightly larger at 30inches in diameter; and,
- The tempering air fans no longer inside a building and will have silencer housing on inlet ducts. Each unit will have two 2,000-hp single speed fans on the west side of each unit.

On April 25, 2012, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project.
- 3. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
