This email is to express how deeply my family, my community and I stand, united in opposition, to the Quail Brush/Santee Power Plant. As currently proposed, this project requires rezoning of an area immediately adjacent to an environmental set aside (Mission Trails Regional Park) and would be within one quarter mile of West Hills High School, Chet F. Harritt and Carlton Oaks Elementary School, as well as thousands of Santee homeowners. For months now we have all been living with this black cloud over our heads and let me tell you it has been very depressing to even think of the environmental, economic, physical and emotional harm you are bringing to all the citizens of Santee and to all the people that love to walk, run, hike or ride through Mission Trails Regional Park.

The location of this plant is ill conceived. We are not saying a power plant isn't needed or shouldn't be built. We are saying the proposed location is an extremely bad idea for many reasons, and, there are many viable alternative locations available. As taxpayers, we are also the ratepayers - we respectfully request your intervention on our behalf - directing the developer to include more efficient technology (turbine vs. internal combustion) and to find a sound and logically chosen alternative location.
