ORDER EXTENDING THE DEADLINE TO EVALUATE THE COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR INVESTIGATION AND COMMITTEE MEETING NOTICE AND AGENDA

On April 13, 2012, CalCERTS, Inc. filed a Complaint Against and Request for Investigation of Valley Duct Testing (Complaint) with the Energy Commission's Chief Counsel. On May 9, 2012, the Commission assigned a committee to the Complaint. Under Commission Regulations section 1232, the assigned committee must take action on the complaint by May 14, 2012, unless the committee presiding member extends the deadline.

In particular, Section 1232 requires an assigned committee to take one of the following actions by May 14, 2012:

- 1. Dismiss the matter upon a determination of insufficiency or lack of merit of the pleadings, specifying whether the dismissal is without prejudice; or
- 2. Serve the complaint or request for investigation on the respondents and any other interested or affected persons.

A committee presiding member may shorten or lengthen the Section 1232 deadline for good cause. (Regs., § 1203, subd. (f).)

Regarding this Complaint proceeding, the presiding member has determined that the newly assigned committee requires additional time to adequately evaluate the Complaint allegations and take appropriate action under Section 1232. Accordingly, the presiding member finds that good cause exists to extend the deadline for committee action on the Complaint to Friday, June 22, 2012.
