Therefore, we urge you to oppose changes to "laws, ordinances, standards and regulations" (LORS) needed to site the "Quail Brush Power Plant" within the Mission Trails Design District of East Elliot and upon a parcel one-half-mile from the San Diego River.

For the record, several groups in attendance did not vote on this matter.
