

Environmental and Energy Standards for Transportation Hydrogen Production - SB1505

California Energy Commission June 29, 2012

SB1505 Overview

 Establishes environmental and energy standards for hydrogen production used in transportation

 Supports movement away from non-renewable transportation


Plant

Solids

SB1505 Requirements

Emissions

- 50% reduction of NOx plus ROG (WTT)
- 30% reduction of greenhouse gas (GHG) (WTW)
- No increase in toxic air contaminants (WTT)

Energy

33.3% of hydrogen produced made from renewable resources

SB1505 Applicability

- Immediately to state co-funded hydrogen stations
- All hydrogen stations upon reaching state-wide threshold of 3,500 metric tons/year
 - 3.5 million kg/yr, ~9,589 kg/day, ~13,500 cars

SB1505 Progress to Date

 Between 2007 to 2010, ARB held workshops and meetings with stakeholders

 Draft regulatory language and Initial Statement of Reason prepared in 2010

- Regulatory package not presented to the Board
 - 2010 implementation of the Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS)

Additional Refinements In Key Areas

- Eligible renewable sources
- Eligible credits
- Definition of regulated parties
- Lifecycle assessment of production pathways
- Determination of 33.3%
- Reporting and determination of compliance

Ensure alignment with existing regulation and simplify implementation

Current Thoughts on Eligible Renewable Sources

- Renewable feedstocks
 - Biomass
 - Digester gas
 - Municipal solid waste or landfill gas
- Renewable electricity
 - Solar thermal or photovoltaic
 - Fuel cell
 - Wind
 - Geothermal
 - Small hydroelectric generation
 - Ocean wave, thermal or tidal

Eligible Renewable Sources (cont')

- Renewable Credits
 - Purchase of Renewable Energy Credits of electricity (WREGIS) or biogas
 - LCFS credits from biomethane, renewable hydrogen or electricity
- List is not all inclusive
- Open to discussion
