## APPLICANT'S RESPONSE TO DATA REQUEST #167

Technical Area: Biological Resources

#### Data Request:

167. State whether any underground infrastructure would be required to operate the heliostats. If underground infrastructure is proposed, please describe the proposed installation methodology, including trench dimensions. Illustrate any areas of proposed ground disturbance necessary for operation of the heliostats on a map and provide drawings of representative trenches or other ground disturbance, including any berms or other grading to divert runoff.

#### Response:

At this stage of the solar field design, the Applicant has not yet determined the actual grouping and routing of each trench that will provide power and communication utilities to the heliostat control network distribution boxes. However, Applicant's engineers were able to determine the allowable electrical loads and communication channel capacities and have prepared a typical loop design. Based on this information, Applicant estimates the following:

- 19 loops for each solar field (RMS 1 and RMS 2)
- Average loop length of 16,000 feet (includes an allowance for field cameras and weather stations)
- Trench width of 30" which will contain 480V AC electrical service and fiber optic communication cables
- Ground disturbance for the solar field control system will be temporary and Applicant does not anticipate any permanent stormwater diversion features (berms, diversion channels) associated with this system.




Figure 167-1: Solar Field Cable Trench Layout and Sections

Figure 167-1 is a depiction of a typical trench and is not necessarily representative of actual route through the field.
