REVISED COMMITTEE SCHEDULING ORDER

On October 8, 2008, the Application for Certification (AFC) was deemed data adequate for the twelve-month review process prescribed in Public Resources Code, section 25540.6. The Committee conducted a public Informational Hearing on December 18, 2008, to discuss the schedule and other issues of concern. On December 31, 2008, we issued a Scheduling Order. The most recent status report indicates that the Applicant is working to respond to Staff data requests that require soil and water sampling and the preparation of a health risk assessment. The completion date is uncertain.

The Committee Schedule contained a list of events that must occur to complete the certification process. At this point, we cannot determine when the case will be ready for hearings. Consequently, we adopt the attached Revised Committee Schedule.

We may modify the schedule at any time upon either our own motion or that of a party. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1709.7(c).) The schedule includes periodic status reports, **reduced in frequency to every four months**, to determine whether case development is progressing satisfactorily, and to bring potential schedule delays or other relevant matters to our attention. If issues arise between reporting intervals, we encourage the parties to file an additional status report or appropriate motion to inform us.
