The Guidelines are being revised to 1) modify the payment process to allow certain documentation and interconnection to be completed after the reservation expiration date under specified conditions, 2) clarify that the program administrator will verify the system generation allocation percentages for virtual net metering systems during the payment process, 3) revise the reservation application form and payment claim form, and 4) make other clarifying and non-substantive changes.
