Dear Mr. Redell:

On May 30, 2012, I sent a letter to you entitled "Compliance with Abengoa Mojave Solar Project Worker Safety-6". In that letter I mentioned how the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) considers your efforts to meet your obligations as described in Condition of Certification **WORKER SAFETY-6** as an indication that Abengoa Mojave Solar (AMS) is and will remain in compliance with **WORKER SAFETY-6**. I also stated that a copy of the final mitigation agreement between AMS and San Bernardino County Fire Department (SBCFD) and proof of mitigation payment had to be submitted to the Compliance Project Manager by September 15, 2012.

On September 25, 2012, I sent another letter reminding you that the Energy Commission had not received proof of agreement between AMS and SBCFD. On September 26, 2012, the Energy Commission received information that the agreement has been approved by AMS and SBCFD and will be presented to the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors on October 23, 2012. With this approved agreement, AMS remains in compliance with Condition of Certification **WORKER SAFETY-6**.
