Thank you for including the County of Riverside in your emails below. Though the County of Riverside is not a formal party to this proceeding, the County has no opposition to CBD's request to extend the comment period to December 7, 2012. As I discussed with Pierre Martinez and Lisa DeCarlo yesterday, the County of Riverside will also be submitting comments on the PSA after CEC Staff's comment deadline of November 14, 2012. All comments and proposed conditions from the County must be adopted by our Board of Supervisors at an open public meeting. County staff will not be submitting those comments and proposed conditions to the Board of Supervisors for adoption until after the CEC public workshops because discussion during those workshops may change County staff's recommendations to the Board. It remains my understanding that the CEC staff workshops are currently tentatively planned for November 14<sup>th</sup> and November 28<sup>th</sup>. County staff currently intends to take this matter to our Board of Supervisors at its December 4<sup>th</sup> Board meeting. I will follow this email with a letter to CEC staff on this issue shortly.

## Hearing Officer Celli,

I read CBD's request as directed to staff and serving to formally memorialize discussions they have had with staff's project manager concerning timing. Organizing the biological resources workshop has been challenging, as it involves multiple parties and agencies with differing availability. This, along with the need to start writing the FSA soon, resulted in identifying November 14<sup>th</sup> as an appropriate time to conduct the workshop. We have confirmed that CBD will be available on that date, though they may not have had the chance to thoroughly review the PSA. We have offered to include biological resources as a topic item at our tentatively scheduled November 28<sup>th</sup> cultural resources workshop as well, allowing CBD the opportunity to engage in additional discussion of biological resources should they need time after the November 14<sup>th</sup> workshop. Staff believes that this approach, while not ideal in the eyes of some, presents the best opportunity for reconciling the interests and needs identified above.

With regard to the public comment period, it is common custom for staff to identify 30 days as the preferred time to receive comments on the PSA in order to allow staff sufficient time to respond to comments in the FSA. As CBD is likely aware, parties and the public may comment on staff's analysis throughout the entire AFC proceeding, through publication of the FSA and Presiding Member's Proposed Decision and ultimately at the Commission's adoption hearing. All comments received during the proceeding are considered, but staff has a narrow window of time to include actual responses in the FSA. Staff will endeavor to respond to comments received after the 30 day period identified in the PSA, but without knowing the number or extent of the comments, cannot guarantee that we will be able to address all of them. We encourage CBD to submit their comments as soon as they can, but will not actively reject comments received after the stated date.

I do not believe that these matters require Committee attention at this time. Staff looks forward to engaging in fruitful discussions with the parties, public, tribes, and interested agencies at the upcoming workshops and will apprise the Committee of the results of these workshops in a Status Report once they are concluded.
