Sunset Greens's Data Request Set Two (SG 53-57)

Background

An Environmental Impact Report ("EIR") must identify and focus on significant environmental effects of the proposed project. Public Resources Code Section 21100(b)(1). To assess the impact of a proposed project on the environment, the lead agency examines the changes to existing environmental conditions that would occur in the affected area if the proposed project were implemented. 14 California Code of Regulations Section 15126.2(a).

Quail Brush Genco, LLC proposes to build a power plant on a site that is located in a "Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone" according to the City of San Diego Fire-Rescue Department and according to Quail Brush's Own Draft Wildfire Response Emergency Plan, submitted in this matter on July 9, 2012. On June 4, 2012, the Fire Chief of the City of San Diego submitted a letter in this matter which detailed that the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department would not be able to meet the City of San Diego's adopted goal of 7.5 minutes for emergency response time for a single unit, and 10.5 minutes for a multiple unit response. The impact the project could have on fire response in this area is highly relevant to the instant proceedings since such information is needed for the state to make an environmentally informed decision under CEQA.

- SG-57 Please provide any and all reports, studies, and/or other documents reasonably available to Quail Brush Genco, LLC, which address emergency response times impacted by the project.
