Request for Additional Extension of Time to Submit Responses to Staff's Data

Requests, Set 1A (AQ-11, BIO-23, BIO-24, BIO-25, BIO-26)

#### Dear Commissioners:

On or about October 2, 2012, California Energy Commission Staff issued Data Requests, Set 1A (#1-72) ("Data Requests") for the Huntington Beach Energy Project Application for Certification proceeding, and identified November 2, 2012 as the date by which responses to such Data Requests were due. On October 22, 2012, Applicant AES Southland Development, LLC ("Applicant") submitted a request for extension of time to respond to certain Data Requests pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1716(f). Specifically, Applicant requested an extension of time to respond to Data Requests AQ-11, BIO-23, BIO-24, BIO-25, and BIO-26. At the time of the initial request for extension of time to respond, Applicant anticipated filing responses to these specific Data Requests on or before December 14, 2012. However, as noted in footnote 1 of Applicant's October 22, 2012 correspondence to the Siting Committee, preparation of such responses requires certain information from the South Coast Air Quality Management District ("SCAQMD"). To date, Applicant has received approximately 85 percent of the information in response to its Public Records Act request submitted to the SCAQMD on October 5, 2012 and is currently reviewing the data. Applicant will follow up with



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phone calls and additional Public Records Act requests as needed to complete the modeling and responses to requests AQ-11, BIO-23, BIO-24, BIO-25, and BIO-26.

Based on the foregoing and the intervening holiday season, Applicant respectfully requests the Committee grant Applicant's additional request for extension to respond to the aforementioned Data Requests until **January 18, 2013**.
