SUBJECT: Lodging Options in Blythe

COMMENTS:

I called Mr. Perez to discuss lodging options in Blythe during construction of the Rio Mesa SEGF. He believes that there would be plenty of lodging options for workers who relocate to the local area during construction including hotel/motels, RV trailer parks, and rental houses. Lodging is available for ongoing solar construction projects similar to the situation when the prisons were built. Given the prevailing wages for construction workers that would be involved in the Rio Mesa project, affordable lodging would be available for those workers who temporarily relocate in the local area. Workers usually take the initiative with other colleagues and share affordable lodging information as appropriate and often room together in a motel or house to keep individual rental costs as low as possible.
