I talked to Ms. Mendez about lodging availability for relocated construction workers that would be needed to build the Rio Mesa SEGF. She said the busiest time of year is January when the city of Quartzite holds a rock and gem show. The rate for current solar construction project workers is \$55.99 per day which constitutes 70 percent of her business. Ms. Mendez believes other motels probably have similar arrangements and there would be adequate lodging options for Rio Mesa construction workers who temporarily relocate to the local area.
