This morning I attempted to open the electronic copy of Exhibit 2, Mr. Coleman's photos, that you filed via a CD last week. The file Dockets received was "Bottle Rock power Photos 2008-2010" without a file extension indicating the type of file. I tried several programs, including two that open compressed archives of various types, and was unable to view the picture(s). I don't know whether the parties who received copies directly from you were able to view them but the Committee, Commission staff, and the official record do not have readable copies. They may not be relied upon until properly filed in a readable form.

Please immediately file and serve the photos in a form that allows us to view them. The newly filed Exhibit 2 will supersede the previous filing, though both will remain in the Docket files.
