REVISED COMMITTEE SCHEDULING ORDER

Background

On July 31, 2008, Hydrogen Energy International, LLC (HEI) filed an Application for Certification (AFC) seeking authority to construct and operate the Hydrogen Energy California Project (HECA), an integrated gasification combined cycle (IGCC) power generating facility rated at a nominal gross generating capacity of 390 megawatts (MW). To avoid conflict with habitat for endangered species in the original location for the project, HEI retracted the original AFC and filed a revised application on May 28, 2009, for the same project to be built at a different location. An Informational Hearing and Site Visit were conducted on September 16, 2009. The proposed HECA would be located near the unincorporated community of Tupman in western Kern County, California, seven miles west of the city limit of Bakersfield.

SCS Energy California, LLC acquired 100 percent ownership of HECA, LLC in September, 2011, undertook the re-design of some aspects of the project, and submitted an Amended AFC in May 2012. The Energy Commission assigned a Committee of two Commissioners to conduct proceedings on the AFC. The Committee held a public Site Visit and Informational Hearing at the Elk Hills School in Tupman on July 12, 2012, to discuss the review process and to identify issues that could affect the schedule. Pursuant to Title 20, of the California Code of Regulations, section 1709.7(c), the Committee issued a Scheduling Order based on Staff's proposed schedule and related discussions at the Informational Hearing.

The attached revised schedule is based upon information submitted by the parties in status reports, and at the Status Conference held January 16, 2013, concerning their progress in reviewing the AFC. It contains a list of events that must occur in order to complete the certification process.

This revised schedule covers the period up to the Prehearing Conference with the balance of the schedule to be determined at the Prehearing Conference. The Committee encourages the parties to consider this schedule an outer boundary and

make their best efforts to complete the milestones ahead of these dates. Some deadlines may be contingent upon reviews to be conducted by federal, state, and local agencies. The Applicant must provide sufficient review time for the responsible agencies to meet the deadlines specified in the schedule.

Status Reports

The attached schedule requires status reports to be submitted by all parties. Status reports shall inform the Committee whether or not case development is progressing satisfactorily, and bring potential schedule delays and other relevant matters to the Committee's attention.

The reports shall be received by the other parties and the Commission's Docket Unit, 1516 Ninth Street, MS-4, Sacramento, California 95814-5512, **and must be filed no later than 3:00 p.m.** on the due date. Status reports must contain "Docket No. 08-AFC-08A" in the caption or heading. The parties shall e-mail their status reports to those with e-mail addresses as indicated on the Service List.

Public Adviser and Public Participation

The Energy Commission invites members of the public and other interested parties to participate either on an informal basis or by intervening in the proceeding. Both types of participation allow written and oral comments. At the informal participation level, written and oral public comments are considered by the Commissioners and are part of the record, but are not part of the formal evidentiary record. Intervenors have the right to introduce evidence into the evidentiary record and cross-examine the other parties' witnesses.
