Water Director – Responsible for directing the Inyo County Water Department, which is charged with implementation of Inyo County's water policies. These policies stem primarily from the County's interactions with the City of Los Angeles's water export activities in Inyo County, and from the County's regulation of groundwater transfers. The Water Department's activities include monitoring hydrologic conditions, monitoring vegetation conditions potentially affected by water management activities, assessing potential effects of proposed groundwater pumping, developing and implementing mitigation measures for adverse impacts due to groundwater pumping, monitoring mitigation activities, integrated regional water management planning, invasive species control, advising decision makers regarding water issues, and informing and educating the public regarding County water issues.

Hydrologist – Responsible for collecting, analyzing, and reporting on hydrologic conditions related to Inyo County water policies. Duties included hydrologic data collection and interpretation; groundwater model development, review, and application; monitoring network design; development of monitoring and mitigation plans aimed at mitigating impacts of groundwater pumping; and multidisciplinary teamwork to assess effects of hydrologic changes on biological resources.
