Modification Description: Petition to Amend submitted by Calpine Gilroy Cogen, L.P., to install two new Selective Catalytic Reduction units on the project's two auxiliary boilers and proposed conditions of certification AQ-SC-1 thru AQ-SC-7 and modifications to condition 1.3.
