I need to get a revised project description for the gas pipeline based on the revised map that you provided. What we have right now reads as follows:

The Approved Project did not include a natural gas supply pipeline but rather was approved to use LPG for its auxiliary fuel. The Modified Project will use natural gas to fire its auxiliary and nighttime preservation boilers. The natural gas supply for PSEGS will be provided by SoCal Gas, which will upgrade and extend an existing distribution line from its main transmission gas pipeline located approximately 1.8 miles west and south of the site. The existing distribution facilities will be upgraded from a 4 inch pipeline to an 8 inch pipeline. Additionally, SoCal Gas will permit and construct a new 8 inch gas pipeline extension from the current retail meter point to the new PSEGS meter to be located within the common area. SoCal Gas will construct, own and operate the new distribution line as part of its extensive gas supply system.

The new gas pipeline will be approximately 8-inches in diameter and will be approximately 2956 feet long and will be constructed within a previously surveyed corridor as shown on Figure 2.1-6, dated and docketed on March 15, 2013. SoCal Gas will construct, own and operate the new gas pipeline as part of its extensive gas supply system.


