

RE: San Diego Gas & Electric Company's request for extension to submit demand forecast forms in support of the *2013 Integrated Energy Policy Report*


Dear Ms. Wrazen:

This letter responds to your May 17, 2013, written request to extend the filing deadline for submitting revenue requirement forms. According to forms and instructions adopted by the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) on December 12, 2013, this information is to be submitted by June 3, 2013, for our assessment work as part of the *2013 Integrated Energy Policy Report (IEPR)*. San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) is requesting a 21-day extension of this filing deadline.

According to Section 1342(c) of California Code of Regulations, Title 20, Division 2, Article 2, the executive director must receive the application for an extension 15 days before the report is due. Since the report is due to the Energy Commission on June 3, 2013, SDG&E meets this requirement for requesting an extension.

I understand that SDG&E experienced unexpected delays in obtaining information needed to produce its energy and peak forecasts and that those delays have impacted other dependent analyses. I also appreciate SDG&E's efforts in working with Energy Commission staff to ensure that these delays have a minimal impact on our own analytical work. With the understanding that a 21-day extension will allow SDG&E sufficient time to develop a revenue requirement assessment consistent with your most recent demand forecast and resource plan, I agree to accept the revenue requirements portion of the *IEPR* demand forecast forms from SDG&E by June 24, 2013.
