**NOTICE OF RECEIPT****PETITION TO AMEND****the CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION DECISION for the
SACRAMENTO POWER AUTHORITY CAMPBELL COGENERATION PROJECT
(93-AFC-3C)**

On May 16, 2013, Sacramento Power Authority (SPA) filed a petition with the California Energy Commission requesting to amend Condition of Certification **EFF-1** for the Campbell Cogeneration Project (SPAC). The 158-megawatt project was certified by the Energy Commission on November 30, 1994, and began commercial operation in 1997. The facility is located in the City of Sacramento, in Sacramento County.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION

Due to the loss of the Campbell food processing plant steam host, SPA requests modification of Condition of Certification **EFF-1** to allow the operation of SPAC in the absence of a steam host, without being required to demonstrate compliance with the California Code of Regulations governing cogeneration facilities. SPA is also requesting to install a blind flange on the export steam line to reduce energy losses by allowing the steam to be used in the power plant rather than being directed to a steam host.

ENERGY COMMISSION AMENDMENT REVIEW PROCEDURES

The purpose of the Energy Commission's review process is to assess the impacts of this proposal on environmental quality and on public health and safety. The review process includes an evaluation of the consistency of the proposed changes with the Energy Commission's Decision and a determination on whether the facility, as modified, would remain in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769). Energy Commission staff is currently analyzing the request and will publish an analysis in the near future. A public hearing for the purpose of approving, denying, or modifying the amendment proposal will be held at a regularly scheduled Energy Commission business meeting.
