**NOTICE OF RECEIPT**  
**PETITION TO AMEND**  
**the CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION DECISION for the**  
**SEGS VIII SOLAR FACILITY (88-AFC-1C)**

On June 11, 2013, NextEra Energy Resources filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to modify the SEGS VIII facility. The 80-megawatt facility was certified by the Energy Commission in its Decision on March 29, 1989, and began commercial operation in December, 1989. The facility is located near Hinkley in San Bernardino County, California.

**DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION**

The modification proposed in the petition (and addendum to the petition received on June 27, 2013) would construct a 1,600-square-foot foundation and single-story building on the SEGS VIII facility site, to be used as a combined employee break room and training/conference facility.

**ENERGY COMMISSION AMENDMENT REVIEW PROCEDURES**

The purpose of the Energy Commission's review process is to assess the impacts of this proposal on environmental quality and on public health and safety. The review process includes an evaluation of the consistency of the proposed changes with the Energy Commission's Decision and a determination on whether the facility, as modified, would remain in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769). Energy Commission staff is currently analyzing the request and will publish an analysis in the near future. A public hearing for the purpose of approving, denying, or modifying the amendment proposal will be held at a regularly scheduled Energy Commission business meeting.

Any person may file written comments on the petition with the Energy Commission's Dockets Unit. All written comments and all materials filed with the Dockets Unit will


become part of the public record of the proceeding and may be posted to the Energy Commission's website for this facility.
