Background

Senate Bill 1389 (Bowen, Chapter 568, Statutes of 2002) requires the Energy Commission to adopt an integrated energy policy report (IEPR) every two years. The objective of the IEPR is to evaluate market trends and develop energy policies that will "conserve resources, protect the environment, ensure energy reliability, enhance the

state's economy, and protect public health and safety." (Public Resources Code § 25301[a]). The Final 2013 IEPR has been prepared in response to this direction.

The Final 2013 IEPR examines a range of issues facing the state's electricity, natural gas, and transportation fuel sectors. Energy efficiency, demand response, and renewable energy remain the top priorities for meeting California's energy needs. Challenges facing California's energy sector include the phase out of power plants that use once-through-cooling, the retirement of the large San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, the increasing need for flexibility to integrate renewable resources into the grid, and climate change. The report provides analysis of various energy issues and recommendations to address the challenges facing California's energy sector. To prepare the report, the Energy Commission conducted 28 public workshops throughout the 2013 IEPR proceeding. On October 2, 2013, the Energy Commission released the Draft 2013 IEPR and held a workshop on October 15, 2013 to solicit public comments on the draft report. In preparing the Final 2013 IEPR, commissioners considered all oral and written comments on the draft report.

Written Comments

The Energy Commission will accept comments on the Final 2013 IEPR and requests parties to submit comments in writing by close of business **January 9, 2014**, so that comments can be considered prior to the January 15, 2014, Business Meeting. Comments will also be accepted at the Business Meeting. All written comments will become part of the public record of this proceeding. Additionally, written comments may be posted to the Energy Commission's website for the proceeding.
