Re: MCE's Comments on the Preliminary California Energy Demand Updated Forecast, 2015-2025

Marin Clean Energy (MCE) appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the California Energy Commission's (CEC's) Preliminary California Energy Demand Updated Forecast, 2015-2025.

MCE is California's first operational Community Choice Aggregator (CCA). MCE currently serves approximately 125,000 accounts in the County of Marin and the City of Richmond. In 2015, MCE will begin serving the unincorporated areas of Napa County and the cities of Benicia and San Pablo.

MCE is particularly appreciative of CEC staff efforts to delineate CCA load in its forthcoming 2014 Integrated Energy Resource Plan (IEPR) Update. MCE requests that the CEC continue to include in the IEPR not only MCE's load, but load from other CCAs as well, such as Sonoma Clean Power and Lancaster Choice Energy.
