Dear Adrian,

I am writing in support of the proposed Title 24 2016 language granting exemptions from code requirements in the case of one-for-one luminaire or luminaire component replacement where the new luminaires or components have the same or lower power consumption than the existing condition. I believe this will enable institutions such as Stanford University to continue group re-ballast programs interrupted by the 2013 requirements for "luminaire modifications in place". Stanford's group re-ballast program has been a major source of lighting efficiency improvements over time as we are able to leverage maintenance and energy-efficiency funding.
